**She Should Run** – Through this award-winning recruitment program, WCF builds a pipeline of pro-choice women candidates by creating a formal process for citizens to nominate talented women who should run and connecting those women with the essential resources they need to make the decision to and then successfully run for office.

**Training Library** – This fall WCF published the first-of-its-kind “Companion Notebook” to help women make the decision to serve. The Notebook demonstrates why women should run, illustrates the options in how they can serve, exposes them to the basic skills needed, and provides practical next steps and resources.

**Endorsements & Candidate Support** – WCF PAC supports women early in their political careers. We pride ourselves on being the “get you started” group that builds our candidates’ credibility and resources to help position them for later-stage supporters and organizations. We have a rigorous endorsement process that evaluates candidates based on their talent and strategy, the viability of the race, and their commitment to choice.

WCF PAC gives out as much as we raise. With the exception of administrative expenses needed to run our bundling program, every dollar we raise goes directly to candidates.

**Membership Building, Engagement and Bundling** – WCF is building a national network of women invested in politics. Every member we add is someone we can ask to support our endorsed candidates with words, deeds and funds.
